

Needham High School's Students Acting to Make a Difference, also called SAMD, opens its 2023 production, the satirical comedy Urinetown, on Friday, October 27th at 7 pm, with two more weekend performances on Saturday, October 28th at 7pm and Sunday, October 29th at 2 pm. The show will be presented at Newman Elementary School on 1155 Central Avenue, with over 40 students in the cast playing a variety of over-the-top characters, and even more working in technical roles to make the production possible. The musical tells the story of a revolution in a dystopian world where citizens must pay to use public toilets, with a script filled with laugh-out-loud lines and cutting satirical commentary.

Students Acting to Make a Difference is student-led organization which aims to create concrete change in Needham and the overall Boston and Metro West community by putting on a musical theater production every year to raise funds for a local nonprofit. SAMD aims to provide NHS students with the opportunity to give back to the greater Boston area through their passion for performing arts, all the while creating a supportive, creative, and judgment-free rehearsal environment.

This year, SAMD partnered with the nonprofit Circle of Hope, based in Needham. Circle of Hope provides homeless individuals in Boston and Metro West with necessities including clothing, shoes, linens, and hygiene products. They work with 25 different homeless shelters, healthcare clinics, and community programs to distribute these items. See their website, https://www.circleofhopeonline.org/, for more information.
